



Youth skills have never been so vital. One young person, aged 15-24, in eight across the world is looking for work. Youth populations are large and growing, especially in the urban areas of low-income countries. With one quarter of the world's youth earning no more than \$1.25 a day, un-skilled young people are being trapped in working poverty for life.

Launched on October 16, [UNESCO's 10th Education for All Global Monitoring Report](#), "Putting Education to Work", could not be better timed. It looks in depth at youth skills, one of the least analyzed of the "Education for All" Goals set in 2000.
