



### **16.0.2016 – UN General Assembly President Mogens Lykketoft is in Brussels on a two day visit.**

Mr Lykketoft is due to meet European Commission President Jean-Claude Juncker, High Representative for Foreign Affairs Federica Mogherini, EU Parliament President Martin Schulz, and several EU commissioners. He will also be received by Her Majesty Queen Mathilde of Belgium, who was recently nominated as an [Advocate for the Sustainable Development Goals \(SDGs.\)](#)

In a press conference delivered at UNRIC headquarters in Brussels on 16 February, he spoke about the most pressing issues he faces such as the need to hold governments to account on the implementation of the [Paris Climate Agreement](#) and ensuring the early and strong implementation of the [2030 Development Agenda](#) and the [SDGs](#).

Mr Lykketoft delivered insights into the selection of the new Secretary General, an ongoing process he described as exciting and revolutionary in its increased transparency and broader influence from UN membership and public opinion.
