



Deputy Secretary-General Amina Mohammed commended European leaders for their leadership and commitment to the 17 Sustainable Development Goals and the 2030 Agenda.

In an address on 7 June, at the opening of the European Development Days in Brussels, the Deputy Secretary-General also called for “strengthening bonds of solidarity” to achieve the 17 Sustainable Development Goals and stressed the need for “partnerships that deliver.”

The Deputy Secretary-General told an audience of world leaders, senior EU officials, private and civil society representatives, as well as youth leaders and Sustainable Development Goals Advocates, including Queen Mathilde of the Belgians, that the UN recognized “the remarkable achievements of Europe” and welcomed the signing of the new European Consensus for Development.
