

On 24th January 2019, Ciné-ONU screened 'The School in the Cloud' in partnership with the Embassies of the UK and Ireland and UNESCO at Cinéma Galeries in Brussels. The event was organised to mark the first International Day of Education, and to raise awareness for Sustainable Development Goal 4: Quality Education.



'The School in the Cloud' follows a three year experiment as Sugata Mitra installs internet kiosks in locations ranging from remote villages in West Bengal to a school in north east England, to enable children to self-organise their learning. Jerry Rothwell's film explores the impact of Professor Mitra's work, predominantly through the experience of children in the remote Indian village of Korakati in the Ganges Delta. As children encounter the internet for the first time, will they be able to use it to transform their futures?
