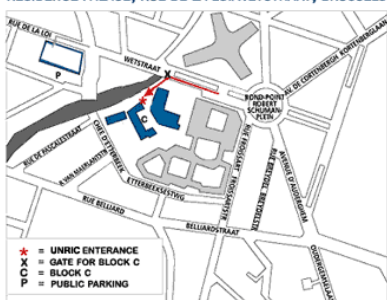
In part two, we will screen four short films on global issues such as HIV/AIDS, Developments Goals and woman's role in peace negotiations.
